A recent nationwide survey indicates that an alarming 70% of puppies and kittens do not complete their vaccine programs for newborns. These animals are not adequately protected from potentially deadly viral and parasitic infections. Rabies is reaching nationwide epidemic proportions, as is heartworm disease in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. Distemper and Parvovirus are among the leading causes of deaths in newborns. Intestinal parasites are a frequent cause of diarrhea and poor health and may, if left untreated, predispose your pet to more serious disease. For these reasons, the Pleasant Valley Animal Hospital has instituted THE FIRST YEAR OF LIFE PROGRAM for Puppies and Kittens.

The Program is individually designed by our veterinarians to provide your pet with the necessary vaccinations and laboratory tests for intestinal parasites, Canine Heartworm/tick-borne diseases as well as Feline Leukemia/Fiv and Feline Heartworm Disease.

The Program is designed to promote affordable preventative health care for your pet. An extended Program is available to also include routine castration, spay and/or declaw operations.

Once the program and terms are accepted, a 15% discount will be incorporated into each fyol visit that includes the itemized services outlined in program and a 20% discount on the surgical procedure. **We cannot however include a discount for any services, medications or laboratory tests that are not indicated in your Program.**

Also, animals that are in heat, pregnant or have complications during surgery may incur additional charges. Optional laser and/or bloodwork are additional as well at the time of surgery.
