Why your Pet Needs Professional Dental Cleaning

Help your pet live a happier, healthier, & longer life!

Oral Disease is the most frequently diagnosed health problem for pets!

Without proper preventative or therapeutic care, **plaque** and **tartar buildup** leads to periodontal disease, which affects the tissues and structures supporting the teeth.

Tartar has a contributory role due to its roughened surface, which enhances bacterial attachment and further plaque development, and also irritates gingival tissues.

Periodontal disease causes red, swollen and tender gums, receding gums, bleeding, pain, bad breath and, if left untreated, can lead to tooth loss.

The **inflammation** and **infection** associated with periodontal disease may damage other organs such as the heart, liver, and kidneys, or lead to other serious health problems.

Our surgical procedures include:

- **Pre-Anesthetic Bloodwork** – ensures your pet is healthy enough to undergo the surgical procedure and that his/her internal organs can safely process the anesthesia
- **Sevoflurane Anesthesia** – a very safe anesthetic gas for rapid recovery from the procedure
 - ❖ **Experienced Nursing Support** – our trained technicians use state of the art anesthetic monitors to continuously monitor your pet's pulse rate and respiration
 - ❖ **IV catheter Placement** – fluids are given during surgery to maintain blood pressure and to help your pet recover quickly from anesthesia
 - ❖ **Pain Management** – is administered when necessary during surgical procedure to ensure your pet's comfort
